

What To Do Immediately After A Car Accident

Check for Injuries



If any of the injuries appear to be serious, call an ambulance.

If you're not sure whether the injury is serious or not, it's better to be safe than sorry and call the ambulance.






Move Your Vehicle


If possible, get your car off the road as soon as you can. To alert oncoming traffic of the accident, set up road flares or warning triangles if you have any. It's always a good idea to keep this kind of equipment in your trunk or glove compartment.















damage Take pictures and notes of all the damage done to all vehicles

Document all

involved in the accident. These will act as records for proof of damage in potential personal injury or insurance claims.

Exchange information with people at the scene. Get the information of other drivers involved in the accident, including name,

phone number, email, address, license plate, insurance information and more.


When talking to police and to other drivers, make sure that you never take responsibility for the accident. This could seriously hurt your chances




